※Collection service is also provided on national holidays unless they fall on Saturdays and Sundays.

## Cannot be placed on the Collection Points

## Toxic Waste (must be in a transparent bag)

ONot at the regular pickup point, but place at the point designated by jichikai, or neighborhood association.
-pickup day: $\quad$ once a month $\quad$ The third Friday
•items Dry batteries, Fluorescents, Mirrors, Lighters, Thermometers

Cannot be collected by the city (Contact Operation Sec., Kankyoueisei-ka Fukaya-shi.)
OMotorbikes, Batteries, Tires, Boilers, Extinguishers, Construction waste, gas canisters, etc.


OTVs, Air Conditioners, Refrigerators, and Washing Machines $\rightarrow$ Have them collected by the store of original purchase, or by the store of new purchase


## 〈Be well mannered in disposing waste by observing the three rules below.〉

1. The designated kind of waste, On the designated pickup day,

In the designated bag. (Waste must be separated in each different group.)
2. Must be placed at the designated pickup point no later than 8:30 a.m.
(Not on the day before or after the collection)
3. Keep clean your collection spots.
(Take turns at cleaning the spots after the collection .)
